Deuteronomy 18:18 I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put my words in his mouth; and he shall speak at unto them all that I shall command him.

19 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever will not hearken unto my words which he shall speak in my name, I will require it of him.

20 But the prophet, which shall presume to speak a word in my name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or that shall speak in the name of other gods, even that prophet shall die.

**John 12:49 For I have not
spoken of myself; but the
Father which sent me, he
gave me a commandment,
what I should say, and what I
should speak.**

John 5:23 That all men should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him.

24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.

John 5:30 I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me.

John 5:36 But I have greater witness than that of John: for the works which the Father hath given me to finish, the same works that I do, bear witness of me, that the Father hath sent me.

Typology of the second coming in the life of Moses

- Moses revealed himself the first time but was rejected by His brethen but the second time Moses showed himself was with the power and the name of YHVH as a redeemer of Israel
- Yahshua when HE first revealed to HIS brothers they rejected him but the second time Yahshua will show himself to his brethen He is coming with the name of YHVH as the Redeemer of Israel

Midrash Rabbah - Numbers XI:2

. My beloved spoke, and said unto me (S.S. II, 10).
He said, I am the YHVH thy Elohim (Ex. XX, 2).
Another exposition of the text, ' My beloved is like
a gazelle ': Israel, explained R. Isaac, said to the
Holy One, blessed be He: ' Sovereign of the
Universe! Thou hast told us that Thou wilt come to
us first.' ' My beloved is like a gazelle '; as the
gazelle appears and then disappears, so the first
redeemer appeared and then disappeared.

"And as for the wonders that are not the work of Adonai, when he, that is the Messiah, comes then he will heal the sick, resurrect the dead, and to the poor announce glad tidings." [4Q521, Dead Sea Scrolls at Qumran]

[Midrash Ruth Rabbath 5:6]

"He will be with the last deliverer, (*Messiah*), as with the first (*Moses*); as the first deliverer revealed himself first to the Israelites and then withdrew, so also will the last deliverer reveal himself to the Israelites and then withdraw for a while."

Midrash Rabbah - Ruth V:6

The fifth interpretation makes it refer to the Messiah .
COME HITHER: approach to royal state. AND EAT OF THE BREAD refers to the bread of royalty; AND DIP THY MORSEL IN THE VINEGAR refers to his sufferings, as it is said, But he was wounded because of our transgressions (Isa. LIII, 5). AND SHE SAT BESIDE THE REAPERS, for he will be deprived of his sovereignty for a time, as it is said, For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle; and the city shall be taken (Zech. XIV, 2). AND THEY REACHED HER PARCHED CORN, means that he will be restored to his throne, as it is said, And he shall smite the land with the rod of his mouth (Isa. XI, 4). **R. Berekiah said in the name of R. Levi: The future Redeemer will be like the former Redeemer.³ Just as the former Redeemer revealed himself and later was hidden from them**

Yahshua and Moses with the bread send from heaven

Exodus 16:4 Then said the YHVH unto Moses, Behold, I will rain bread from heaven for you; and the people shall go out and gather a certain rate every day, that I may prove them, whether they will walk in my law, or no.

John 6:33 **For the bread of Elohim is he which cometh down from heaven, and giveth life unto the world.**

34 Then said they unto him, YHVH, evermore give us this bread.

35 And Yahshua said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.

Moses mother and Yahshua and his mother

- Moses mother was under bondage of the Egyptians as a slave
- Miriam was under bondage of the Roman Authority

Who kept Moses and Yahshua saved during the early stages of their lives

- Exodus 2:7 Then said his sister to Pharaoh's daughter, Shall I go and call to thee a nurse of the Hebrew women, that she may nurse the child for thee?
- Miriam kept Yahshua save

Moses and Yahshua both left Egypt

- Exodus 2:15 Now when Pharaoh heard this thing, he sought to slay Moses. But Moses fled from the face of Pharaoh, and dwelt in the land of Midian: and he sat down by a well.
- Mathew 2:15 And was there until the death of Herod: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the YHVH by the prophet, saying, Out of Egypt have I called my son.
 - Ho 11:1

Moses going to Egypt Yahshua entering the City of Yerusalem

- Exodus 4:20 **And Moses took his wife and his sons, and set them upon an ass, and he returned to the land of Egypt: and Moses took the rod of Elohim in his hand.**
- Zechariah 9: 9 ¶ **Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass.**

Yahshua entered the City on a donkey

Mathew 21:5 Tell ye the daughter of Sion, Behold, thy King cometh unto thee, meek, and sitting upon an ass, and a colt the foal of an ass.

Moises went to Egypt in the name of YHVH / Yahshua came in the name of YHVH

- Exodus 3:13 And Moses said unto God, Behold, when I come unto the children of Israel, and shall say unto them, The Elohim of your fathers hath sent me unto you; and they shall say to me, What is his name? what shall I say unto them?
-
- 14 And Elohim said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.
-
- 15 And Elohim said moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, YHVH Elohim of your fathers, the Elohim of Abraham, the Elohim of Isaac, and the Elohim of Jacob, hath sent me unto you: this is my name for ever, and this is my memorial unto all generations.
- Revelation 1:8 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith YHVH, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.

WHAT IS THE NAME THAT YAHSHUA HAS AT THE SECOND COMING???

Zechariah 14:3 Then shall YHVH go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle.

4 And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, and there shall be a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.

Moses and Yahshua escaped death in their childhood

Exodus 1:15 ¶ And the king of Egypt spake to the Hebrew midwives, of which the name of the one was Shiphrah, and the name of the other Puah:

16 And he said, When ye do the office of a midwife to the Hebrew women, and see them upon the stools; if it be a son, then ye shall kill him: but if it be a daughter, then she shall live.

Matthew 2:16 ¶ Then Herod, when he saw that he was mocked of the wise men, was exceeding wroth, and sent forth, and slew all the children that were in Bethlehem, and in all the coasts thereof, from two years old and under, according to the time which he had diligently enquired of the wise men.

Moses was a prince and gave up his position to become a servant also Yahshua is the Prince and became a servant

- **Hebrews 11:24 By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter;**
- **25 Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season;**
- **Php 2:6 Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:**
- **7 But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men**
- **8 And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.**

Yahshua and Moses were rejected by their Brothers

Exodus 2:13 And when he went out the second day, behold, two men of the Hebrews strove together: and he said to him that did the wrong, Wherefore smitest thou thy fellow?

14 And he said, Who made thee a prince and a judge over us? intendest thou to kill me, as thou killedst the Egyptian? And Moses feared, and said, Surely this thing is known.

Matthew 27:20 But the chief priests and elders persuaded the multitude that they should ask Barabbas, and destroy Jesus.

21 The governor answered and said unto them, Whether of the twain will ye that I release unto you? They said, Barabbas.

22 Pilate saith unto them, What shall I do then with Yahshuawhich is called Christ? They all say unto him, Let him be crucified

Moses extends his hand and the red sea opens and Yahshua with power to calm the seas

- Exodus 14:21 ¶ And Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and YHVH caused the sea to go back by a strong east wind all that night, and made the sea dry land, and the waters were divided.
- Matthew 8:26 And he saith unto them, Why are ye fearful, O ye of little faith? Then he arose, and rebuked the winds and the sea; and there was a great calm.
- 27 But the men marvelled, saying, What manner of man is this, that even the winds and the sea obey him!

Moses turns the Nile into blood and Yahshua turn water into WINE

- Exodus 7:16 And thou shalt say unto him, YHVH Elohim of the Hebrews hath sent me unto thee, saying, Let my people go, that they may serve me in the wilderness: and, behold, hitherto thou wouldest not hear.
-
- 17 Thus saith YHVH , In this thou shalt know that I am YHVH : behold, I will smite with the rod that is in mine hand upon the waters which are in the river, and they shall be turned to blood.
- John 2:7 Yahshua saith unto them, Fill the waterpots with water. And they filled them up to the brim.
-
- 8 And he saith unto them, Draw out now, and bear unto the governor of the feast. And they bare it.
-
- 9 When the ruler of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and knew not whence it was: (but the servants which drew the water knew;) the governor of the feast called the bridegroom,

Moses and Yahshua both became a stumbling stone

- Exodus 10:7 And Pharaoh's servants said unto him, How long shall this man be a snare unto us? let the men go, that they may serve YHVH their God: knowest thou not yet that Egypt is destroyed?
- 1Peter 2:8 And a stone of stumbling, and a rock of offence, even to them which stumble at the word, being disobedient: whereunto also they were appointed.

Moses and Yahshua were almost stoned

- Exodus 17:4 And Moses cried unto YHVH , saying, What shall I do unto this people? they be almost ready to stone me.
- John 8:59 Then took they up stones to cast at him: but Yahshua hid himself, and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by.

Moses and Yahshua took 12 Leaders

- Deuteronomy 1:23 **And the saying pleased me well: and I took twelve men of you, one of a tribe**
- Mark 3:13 ¶ **And he goeth up into a mountain, and calleth unto him whom he would: and they came unto him.**
- **14 And he ordained twelve, that they should be with him, and that he might send them forth to preach,**

Moses and Yahshua selected 70 Leaders

- Numbers 11:16 ¶ And YHVH said unto Moses, Gather unto me seventy men of the elders of Israel, whom thou knowest to be the elders of the people, and officers over them; and bring them unto the tabernacle of the congregation, that they may stand there with thee.
- Luke 10:1 ¶ After these things YHVH appointed other seventy also, and sent them two and two before his face into every city and place, whither he himself would come.

[Midrash Ruth Rabbath 5:6]

Moses and Yahshua as Deliverers of Israel

- Exodus 3:10 Come now therefore, and I will send thee unto Pharaoh, that thou mayest bring forth my people the children of Israel out of Egypt.
- Romans 11:26 And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Sion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob:

Pharaoh's heart hardened just like the world will hardened their hearts

- Exodus 7:13 And he hardened Pharaoh's heart, that he hearkened not unto them; as YHVH had said.
- Revelation 16:9 And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of God, which hath power over these plagues: and they repented not to give him glory.
-
- 10 And the fifth angel poured out his vial upon the seat of the beast; and his kingdom was full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues for pain,
-
- 11 And blasphemed the Elohim of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and repented not of their deeds.

Israel suffered lack of trust

- Exodus 32:1 ¶ And when the people saw that Moses delayed to come down out of the mount, the people gathered themselves together unto Aaron, and said unto him, Up, make us gods, which shall go before us; for as for this Moses, the man that brought us up out of the land of Egypt, we wot not what is become of him.
- 2Peter 3:3 ¶ Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts,
- 4 And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation

Moses the servant / Yahshua the servant

- **Psalms 105:26**
He sent Moses
his servant; and
Aaron whom he
had chosen.
- Matthew 12:18 Behold
my servant, whom I
have chosen; my
beloved, in whom my
soul is well pleased: I
will put my spirit upon
him, and he shall shew
judgment to the
Gentiles.

Moses the Prophet / Yahshua the Prophet

- Deuteronomy 18:17 And YHVH said unto me, They have well spoken that which they have spoken.
- 18 I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put my words in his mouth; and he shall speak unto them all that I shall command him.
- 19 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever will not hearken unto my words which he shall speak in my name, I will require it of him.
- John 6:14 Then those men, when they had seen the miracle that Yahshua did, said, This is of a truth that prophet that should come into the world.

Moses the High Priest / Yahshua the Kohen HaGadol

- Psalms 99:6 ¶ Moses and Aaron among his priests, and Samuel among them that call upon his name; they called upon YHVH , and he answered them.
- Hebrews 7:24 But this man, because he continueth ever, hath an unchangeable priesthood.

Hebrews 5:6 As he saith also in another place, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.

Moses the shepherd / Yahshua the true shepherd

- Exodus 3:1 ¶ Now Moses kept the flock of Jethro his father in law, the priest of Midian: and he led the flock to the backside of the desert, and came to the mountain of God, even to Horeb.
- John 10:11 I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.
- John 10:14 I am the good shepherd, and know my sheep, and am known of mine

Moses and Yahshua as Mediators of Israel

- Exodus 33:8 And it came to pass, when Moses went out unto the tabernacle, that all the people rose up, and stood every man at his tent door, and looked after Moses, until he was gone into the tabernacle.
- 9 And it came to pass, as Moses entered into the tabernacle, the cloudy pillar descended, and stood at the door of the tabernacle, and YHVH talked with Moses.
- 1Timothy 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between Elohim and men, the man Messiah Yahshua;

Moses and Yahshua making intercession for us.

- Ex 32:31 And Moses returned unto YHVH , and said, Oh, this people have sinned a great sin, and have made them gods of gold.
- 32 Yet now, if thou wilt forgive their sin--; and if not, blot me, I pray thee, out of thy book which thou hast written
- 33 And YHVH said unto Moses, Whosoever hath sinned against me, him will I blot out of my book.
- Romans 8:33 Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is Elohim that justifieth.
- 34 Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.

Moses was very meek man / Yahshua is the meek man

- Numbers 12:3 (Now the man Moses was very meek, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth.)
- Matthew 11:29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.

Moses and Yahshua the faithful Servants

- Hebrews 3:5 And Moses verily was faithful in all his house, as a servant, for a testimony of those things which were to be spoken after;
- Revelation 3:14 ¶ And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith the *Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God;*

Moses gave water to the People / Yahshua is the Living water

- Numbers 20:11 And Moses lifted up his hand, and with his rod he smote the rock twice: and the water came out abundantly, and the congregation drank, and their beasts also.
- John 4:14 But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.
1Corinthians 10:4 And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ.

Moses the King / Yahshua the King of the world

- Deuteronomy 33:4 **Moses commanded us a law, even the inheritance of the congregation of Jacob.**
-
- **5 And he was king in Jeshurun, when the heads of the people and the tribes of Israel were gathered together.**
- 1Timothy 6:14 That thou keep this commandment without spot, unrebukeable, until the appearing of our Adon Yahshua Messiah :
-
- 15 Which in his times he shall shew, who is the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings, and Lord of Lord's

Moses and Yahshua make atonement for your sin.

- Exodus 32:30 ¶ And it came to pass on the morrow, that Moses said unto the people, Ye have sinned a great sin: and now I will go up unto YHVH ; peradventure I shall make an atonement for your sin.
- Romans 5:11 And not only so, but we also joy in Elohim through our Adonai Yahshua Messiah, by whom we have now received the atonement.

Moses and Yahshua as judges of Israel

- Exodus 18:13 ¶ And it came to pass on the morrow, that Moses sat to judge the people: and the people stood by Moses from the morning unto the evening.
- John 8:10 When Yahshua had lifted up himself, and saw none but the woman, he said unto her, Woman, where are those thine accusers? hath no man condemned thee?
 - 11 She said, No man, YHVH . And Yahshua said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.

Moses came with the sign of the leper / Yahshua heals the lepers

- Exodus 4:6 And YHVH said furthermore unto him, Put now thine hand into thy bosom. And he put his hand into his bosom: and when he took it out, behold, his hand was leprous as snow.
- 7 And he said, Put thine hand into thy bosom again. And he put his hand into his bosom again; and plucked it out of his bosom, and, behold, it was turned again as his other flesh.
- Matthew 8:3 And Yahshua put forth his hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.

Babylonian Talmud, Sanhedrin 98b

The Rabbis said: His name is "**the leper scholar,**" as it is written, Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him a leper, smitten of God, and afflicted. [Isaiah 53:4].

The wisdom of Moses and Yahshua

- Acts 7:22 And Moses was learned in all the wisdom of the Egyptians, and was mighty in words and in deeds.
- Col 2:2 That their hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgement of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ;

The knowledge of Moses and Yahshua given by YHVH

- Psalms 103:6 ¶ YHVH executeth righteousness and judgment for all that are oppressed.
- 7 He made known his ways unto Moses, his acts unto the children of Israel.
- 8 YHVH is merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and plenteous in mercy.
- John 5:20 For the Father loveth the Son, and sheweth him all things that himself doeth: and he will shew him greater works than these, that ye may marvel.

Moses and Yahshua got angry

- Exodus 32:19 And it came to pass, as soon as he came nigh unto the camp, that he saw the calf, and the dancing: and Moses' anger waxed hot, and he cast the tables out of his hands, and brake them beneath the mount.
- Matthew 21:12 ¶ And Yahshua went into the temple of God, and cast out all them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves,

Moses and Yahshua spend time in the Desert

- Moses was 40 years in the desert
- Yahshua spend 40 days in the desert

Moses and Yahshua wash the feet of the People

- Leviticus 8:6 And Moses brought Aaron and his sons, and washed them with water.
- John 13:5 After that he poureth water into a bason, and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel wherewith he was girded.

The death of Moses and Yahshua was necessary for the people to enter the promise land

- Joshua 1:2 Moses my servant is dead; now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, thou, and all this people, unto the land which I do give to them, even to the children of Israel.
- John 12:24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit.

Moses and Yahshua blessed the people

- Exodus 39:43 And Moses did look upon all the work, and, behold, they had done it as YHVH had commanded, even so had they done it: and Moses blessed them.
- Luke 24:50 ¶ And he led them out as far as to Bethany, and he lifted up his hands, and blessed them.

YHVH left a counselor after Moses and Yahshua fulfilled their office

- Deuteronomy 31:23 And he gave Joshua the son of Nun a charge, and said, Be strong and of a good courage: for thou shalt bring the children of Israel into the land which I swear unto them: and I will be with thee.
- John 14:16 And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;
- 17 Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.
- 18 ¶ I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you.

Moses and Yahshua gave reference to the Tabernacle

- Exodus 40:1 ¶ And YHVH spake unto Moses, saying,
 - 2 On the first day of the first month shalt thou set up the tabernacle of the tent of the congregation.
 -
- Zec 6:12 And speak unto him, saying, Thus speaketh YHVH of hosts, saying, Behold the man whose name is The BRANCH; and he shall grow up out of his place, and he shall build the temple of the YHVH :

John 2:19 Yahshua answered and said unto them, Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.

Moses and Yahshua kept the Passover

- Exodus 12:21 ¶ Then Moses called for all the elders of Israel, and said unto them, Draw out and take you a lamb according to your families, and kill the passover.
- John 13:1 ¶ Now before the feast of the passover, when Yahshua knew that his hour was come that he should depart out of this world unto the Father, having loved his own which were in the world, he loved them unto the end.
- 2 And supper being ended, the devil having now put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, to betray him;

Ascending and Decending both Yahshua and Moses did it

- Moses
ascended to
the mountain
and descended
- Yahshua
descended from
Heaven and
ascended to
Heaven

Moses and Yahshua Sanctified the People

- Exodus 19:10 And YHVH said unto Moses, Go unto the people, and sanctify them to day and to morrow, and let them wash their clothes,
- Hebrews 13:11 For the bodies of those beasts, whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are burned without the camp.
- 12 Wherefore Yahshua also, that he might sanctify the people with his own blood, suffered without the gate.

Moses and Yahshua as the Redeemers of Israel

- Exodus 6:6 Wherefore say unto the children of Israel, I am YHVH, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will rid you out of their bondage, and I will redeem you with a stretched out arm, and with great judgments:
- Titus 2:13 Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great Elohim and our Saviour Yahshua messiah;
- 14 Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.
