Ekev deals with how to serve the Lord and what God requires of us

Love in the western world is different than the Biblical love

- Western culture is more about feelings and emotion

Biblical love - an action and a commitment to a covenant

Love in the western world is the expression of commitment based on oaths and vows

You serve God because it is your requirement in a covenantal relationship - NOT with the intention of receiving the blessings

We become the vessels through our loyalty to show the world who God is and His character

We are to follow through on our oaths and vows

Supernatural signs are for unbelievers

Deuteronomy 10:12-13

- What we're supposed to do
- Impossible to do if you remove Torah

Our job is to represent Him

Worship in the ANE

- Your sense of value - your "worth"
- Based on your actions and who you serve

Keeping the covenants and oaths is love

God is bound by His word

Love = loyalty

If you are the kingdom - you are to be loyal even unto death because God does everything for you

- We owe it to Him
