Zechariah 14:16



Shaking the Lulav

It is customary to shake the *lulav* lightly at various points while reciting the *hallel*. This was done in the Holy Temple (and still today, in all congregations of authentic Jewish prayer) at several points:

During the words "Give thanks to the L-rd, for He is good; for His mercy endures forever" (this is the first and last verse of Psalms chapter 118); and

During the words "We beseech You, O L-rd, please save!" (Hosha Na)






Estimates of how many people were there during the Feast

Succah 5:1

In the Midrash Rabbah - Bereshit (Genesis) LXX:8, we read, "Why is the name of it called the drawing out of water? Because of the pouring out of the Holy Spirit, according to what is said: 'With joy shall ye draw out of the wells of salvation'" (Yeshayahu 12:3)

<u>HOSHANA RABBAH</u>

Yochanan (John) 7:37-39 On the last and greatest day of the Feast, Yahshua stood and said in a loud voice, "If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink. Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, streams of living water will flow from within him." By this he meant the Spirit, whom those who believed in him were later to receive. Up to that time the Spirit had not been given, since Yahshua had not yet been glorified.

Isaiah 12:1

- And in that day you shall say, O YHVH, I will praise You; though You were angry with me, turn away Your anger, and You shall comfort me.
- 2 Behold, Elohim is my salvation; I will trust and not be afraid for YHVH, YHVH is my strength and my song; He also has become my salvation.
- 3 And with joy you shall draw water out of the wells of salvation.
- 4 And in that day you shall say, Praise YHVH! Call on His name; declare His doings among the people, make mention that His name is exalted.
- 5 Sing to YHVH; for He has done excellent things; this is known in all the earth.
- 6 Cry out and shout, O dweller of Zion; for great is the Holy One of Israel in your midst.

Zechariah connects a fountain of water

Zechariah 13:1 –
In that day there shall be a fountain opened to the house of David and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem for sin and for uncleanness.

Isaiah 44:1

Yet now hear, O Jacob My servant, and Israel whom I have chosen;

2 So says YHVH who made you, and formed you from the womb, who will help you; Fear not,O Jacob My servant, and you, Jeshurun, whom I have chosen.

3 For I will pour water on him who is thirsty, and floods on the dry ground. I will pour My spirit on your seed, and My blessing on your offspring;

Jeremiah 17:13

O YHVH, the Hope of Israel, all who forsake You shall be ashamed. Those who depart from Me shall be written in the earth, because they have forsaken YHVH, the Fountain of living waters.

Jeremiah 2:13

For My people have committed two evils; they have forsaken Me, the Fountain of living waters, to hew out cisterns for themselves, broken cisterns that can hold no water.

Isaiah 55:1

Ho, everyone who thirsts, come to the waters; and he who has no money, come, buy and eat. Yea, come, buy wine and milk without money and without price.

2 Why do you weigh silver for what is not bread? and your labor for what never satisfies? Listen carefully to Me, and eat what is good, and let your soul delight itself in fatness.

3 Bow down your ear, and come to Me; hear, and your soul shall live; and I will make an everlasting covenant with you, even the sure mercies of David.

4 Behold, I have given Him for a witness to the people, a Leader and Commander of peoples.

5 Behold, You shall call a nation that You do not know; a nation that did not know You shall run to You because of YHVH Your Elohim, and for the Holy One of Israel; for He has glorified You.

Ezequiel 47:1

And he led me again to the door of the house. And behold, water came out from under the threshold of the house eastward. For the front of the house is east, and the water came down from under the right side of the house, at the south side of the altar.

YAHSHUA THE PROPHET LIKE UNTO MOSES

De 18:18 I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put my words in his mouth; and he shall speak unto them all that I shall command him.

19 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever will not hearken unto my words which he shall speak in my name, I will require it of him.

20 But the prophet, which shall presume to speak a word in my name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or that shall speak in the name of other gods, even that prophet shall die.

NUMBERS 20:8

Take the rod, and gather thou the assembly together, thou, and Aaron thy brother, and speak ye unto the rock before their eyes; and it shall give forth his water, and thou shalt bring forth to them water out of the rock: so thou shalt give the congregation and their beasts drink.

NUMBERS 20:10

And Moses and Aaron gathered the congregation together before the rock, and he said unto them, Hear now, ye rebels; must we fetch you water out of this rock?

11 And Moses lifted up his hand, and with his rod he smote the rock twice: and the water came out abundantly, and the congregation drank, and their beasts also.

1 Corinthians 10:1-4 —

Moreover, brethren, I would not that ye should be ignorant, how that all our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea; And were all baptized unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea; And did all eat the same spiritual meat; And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Messiah.

Deuteronomy 32:4

He is the <u>Rock</u>; His work is perfect. For all His ways are just, a Elohim of faithfulness, and without evil; just and upright is He.

Deuteronomy 32:15

¶ But Jeshurun waxed fat, and kicked: thou art waxen fat, thou art grown thick, thou art covered with fatness; then he forsook Elohim which made him, and lightly esteemed the *Rock of his salvation*.

Deuteronomy 32:18

You forgot the **Rock** who brought you forth, and ceased to care for Elohim who formed you.

Deuteronomy 32:30

How shall one chase a thousand, and two put ten thousand to flight, unless their *Rock* had sold them and YHVH had shut them up?

31 For their rock is not as our *Rock*, even our enemies themselves being judges.

Isaiah 17:10

Because you have forgotten the Elohim of your salvation, and have not been mindful of the Rock of your strength, therefore you shall plant pleasant plants and shall sow it a fresh shoot.

2Samuel 22:47

YHVH lives! And blessed be my Rock, and exalted be the Elohim, the Rock of my salvation.

Psalms 95:1

Oh come, let us sing to YHVH; let us make a joyful noise to the Rock of our salvation.

Revelation 21:6

And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alef and Tav, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely.

Revelation 22:17

And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely.

- 7 YHVH taketh my part with them that help me: therefore shall I see my desire upon them that hate me.
- 8 It is better to trust in YHVH than to put confidence in man.
- 9 It is better to trust in YHVH than to put confidence in princes.
- 10 All nations compassed me about: but in the name of YHVH will I destroy them. {destroy...: Heb. cut them off}

- 11 They compassed me about; yea, they compassed me about: but in the name of YHVH I will destroy them.
- 12 They compassed me about like bees; they are quenched as the fire of thorns: for in the name of YHVH I will destroy them. {destroy: Heb. cut down}
- 13 Thou hast thrust sore at me that I might fall: but YHVH helped me.
- 14 YHVH is my strength and song, and is become my salvation.
- 15 The voice of rejoicing and salvation is in the tabernacles of the righteous: the right hand of YHVH doeth valiantly.
- 16 The right hand of YHVH is exalted: the right hand of YHVH doeth valiantly.
- 17 I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of YHVH.
 18 YHVH hath chastened me sore: but he hath not given me over unto death.

- 19 ¶ Open to me the gates of righteousness: I will go into them, and I will praise YHVH:
- 20 This gate of YHVH, into which the righteous shall enter.
- 21 I will praise thee: for thou hast heard me, and art become my salvation.
- 22 The stone which the builders refused is become the head stone of the corner.
- 23 This is YHVH'S doing; it is marvellous in our eyes.
- 24 This is the day which YHVH hath made; we will rejoice and be glad in it.
- 25 Save now, I beseech thee, O YHVH: O YHVH, I beseech thee, send now prosperity.
- 26 Blessed be he that cometh in the name of YHVH: we have blessed you out of the house of YHVH.
